Draft Meeting Notes

September 16, 2010

The meeting was called to order at the home of Rosalie and Ralph Webb. Attending were Bernie Meyers, Edith Pilch, Pat U'Ren, Frank U'Ren, Rosalie Webb, Ralph Webb and Susan Stompe.

**Announcements:** A Business Breakfast on Bay/Delta water issues is on Sept.17, Coastal CleanUp is on Sept. 25 Novao projects will leave from the Gazebo at Scottsdale Pond at 9:30, A "Hike Into History" on Mt. Burdell will be Oct. 16. Campaigning for the State Park initiative, Prop. 21, is starting as soon as materials arrive.

**Minutes:** The notes of the July 15 meeting were approved as distributed.

**50 H Lane:** Owners of 50 H Lane had a second hearing the end of August. A complete plan had still not been received by the planning department. The Zoning Administrator denied the application for the horse stables, but approved the plan for a house and second unit. The owner was advised that the illegal construction for a residence within the existing stable structure must be removed.

**Dirt dumping on creek behind Armstrong Nursery:** Susan was notified about many truckloads of dirt being dumped along a creek. After checking it out and working with the neighbors, the city engineering dept. and county flood control, the dirt was removed. A number of trees and shrubs had been removed from along the creek, too.

**North Redwood Blvd.:** The city has suspended work on North Redwood and the General Plan while staff works with the community on the housing issues. The neighborhoods have organized to fight high density housing. A community meeting on housing was held August 31 and others are to be scheduled.

**Mira Monte Marina:** There will be an event at the site on Sept. 26 with food and drink. Tours will be held to show visitors the hill, and tell about the history.

The next meeting will be at the U'Ren's on October 20.
